I could go on and on and drive myself crazy with trying to figure out the perfect answer to each question, but what it comes down to for you and me is to simply trust in Jesus and know that God has called us to live our lives out in faith in the One who lived, died, and rose again for you and me. James 2:22 states it well...Do not merely listen to the Word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

Spruce & Rose Parish Council Unapproved Meeting Minutes February 27, 2024

Meeting was called to order by President Scott Bellefy at 7 PM.

Secretary's Report was read from February 2023 and November 2023. No correction so will be placed on file.

Treasurer's Report from Buddy Erickson was a written report handed out to each member. Motion made by Mark Karol to approve and second by Tim Fugleberg.

Old Business:

Discussion on a fire pit at the Parsonage was brought up and Tim Fugleberg is working on this. Leaf Guards were also discussed and will wait until fall. Deck on front of Parsonage will be looked into to be updated or left as the same footprint in the next couple of months. Lawn Mower was talked about and Keith Peppel is looking into that.

New Business:

Water Softener has been delivered to the Parsonage and is ready to be hooked up as soon as the plumber can get there.
