### Sin and Grace

June is upon us and I would like to share with you two little devotionals. One deals with sin and temptation, the other reminds us of God's extraordinary love for each of us. May they encourage and challenge you as they have me.

#### Adam, Eve, and Me (Read Genesis 2:7-17; 3:6)

As Adam and Eve faced temptation for the first time, many things were true of them that are not true of us. They lived in a perfect environment and uncorrupted society. No family influence could be blamed for their choice to do what is wrong.

Adam and Eve stood in the morning of creation as creatures of great wonder. No sinful heritage, no ravaged surroundings could be blamed for their downfall.

There were also many sins that Adam and Eve couldn't commit. They couldn't commit adultery. They couldn't steal from anyone. They couldn't dishonor their father or mother. They couldn't bear false witness against their neighbor. They couldn't covet their neighbor's property.

But the essence of sin back at the dawn of creation was the same as it is today—defiance of God. At the one crucial point at which they were tempted, Adam and Eve did not take seriously what God had said.

In the temptations we face today, we too must decide if we will believe the Lord and do what He says is right. We too must realize that sin can devastate our relationship with Him. We too will need His forgiveness when we fall.

#### What Are You Worth? (Read Psalm 8)

Sometimes an enemy of God's truth becomes a truth-teller without intending to be.

Celsus, a 2nd-century Roman philosopher, sought to discredit biblical faith. He wrote in his book True Discourse, "The root of Christianity is its excessive valuation of the human soul, and the absurd idea that God takes an interest in man."

Even though Celsus opposed Christianity, he was telling the truth! It does seem absurd to a Goddenier that the Almighty Creator would take such a deep personal interest in mere mortals. Yet that is the very **heart of the GOSPEL**. The Bible reveals that we are made in the image of God (Genesis 1:26). And tied to every one of us is the price-tag of Calvary.

So when we look at it through Christ's eyes, we see that He values us even though we are sinners. Why else would the Savior die for us? There is no room for human pride here—every bit of our worth comes from God. Yet Scripture assures us that God cares for you, me, and all the earth's billions of people (Luke 12:6-7; John 3:16).

Paul wrote in Galatians 2:20, "Christ ... loved me and gave Himself for me." His immeasurable sacrifice tells us that we are of great worth! --Our Daily Bread
