When he was asked about the reaction to his mid-course decision not to le the crowd determine his direction, Mike responded, 'They thought it was funny that I went the right way.'

First-century pagans reacted the same way to the changed lifestyle of their Christian neighbors. The apostle Peter said, 'They think it strange that you do not run with them in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you.' (1 Peter 4:4). Non-Christians still think that followers of Jesus Christ are going in the wrong direction. But actually, believers are headed for the victor's crown and a heavenly home (2 Timothy 4:7-8).

Keep on the right path, no matter how many are running the other way."

My dear friends, stick to the path that God's Word will help us stay on. Remember what Jesus did for you and live for Him with God's strength and guidance. I leave you with these words from Jeremiah 6:16—This is what the LORD says: "Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls."

#### Rose Free Lutheran Church Council Unapproved Meeting Minutes October 22, 2024

Meeting was called to Order by President Tim Fugleberg.

Those present were Tim Fugleberg, Pastor Todd Erickson, Cody Schumann, Keith Peppel, Mike and Sue Rudebusch, Jon Johnson, Orlan Dvergsten, Ben Heuner, Kurt Osweiler and Jean Pederson.

Pastor Todd Erickson read Psalm 139; v 7-12, also read a Devotional of "What Color is God" and then Prayer.

Orlan Dvergsten gave a report about the insulating of the walls of the church with foam. The cost would be about \$10,000.00. Also, a report on the windows: to take out the window and put <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> in insulated glass on both sides of the Stained Glass, with argon gas in between would be in the estimate of \$7200.00 on all 9 windows. There would be additional cost for putting the windows back in the Church. Jon Johnson moved to have this information brought before the Congregation on October 7th for thought, and then on November 3rd at an after-Church Service Meeting. 2nd by Cody Schumann.

Secretary's report from September 24th and October 6th was read and placed on file.

Treasurer's Report was read by Sue Rudebusch. Kurt Osweiler moved to accept the report, 2nd by Keith Peppel.

Child and Youth Safety Policy: The Christian Ed. Committee is looking in to this.

Property Insurance Policy: The premium this year is \$8,633.57, and the Council will be looking into a new policy for the next year.


It was brought to the Council's attention that the back door needs to be fixed, and there are two chairs in the entry that need some fixing. Council members will look into to this.


