As Pastor Todd will be late to the meeting a discussion on the increase in pay or vacation days for the coming year. Pastor Todd had mention to several church members that he would like to have and extra week of vacation for the 2025 year. A discussion followed and a motion by Greg Dahl to accept Pastor Todd's request and seconded by Mark Karol.

A discussion on Sick and Safe, a new law in 2024, was mentioned, and it was learned that Rose and Spruce are in compliance with the law.

The salary reduction for the coming year for Pastor Todd to be used as he needs for ministryrelated expenses will be \$200.00 a month. Motion made by Greg Dahl and 2nd by Cody Schumann.






Additional copies of Jesus A-Z are available at the Rose Church Office. These would make a nice coffee table book & great for kids/grandkids. (Suggested donation \$10)

Primavera Project

The Primavera Project is a giving opportunity through which our district has blessed our brothers and sisters in Brazil with funds to construct church buildings. The need has arisen again! Loiell Dyrud from Our Saviour's in TRF visited with district pastors in November to inform us of a Free Lutheran congregation in Brazil called, "The Garden of Hope," which is in need of a concrete block structure to replace their wooden church building which has suffered from termites. The cost for concrete block building materials and construction for a Primavera Project church is \$20,000. The goal is to raise this amount by Sunday, March 2, 2025.

Congregations throughout our NW MN district are encouraged to join in demonstrating love for The Garden of Hope congregation through the Primavera Project over the coming months.
