## "KISS"

#### Greet one another with a holy kiss.

Rom. 16:16; 1 Cor. 16:20; 2 Cor. 13:12; 1 Thess. 5:26; 1 Peter 5:14

The year 2025 will start just after midnight December 31, 2024. Many will start the New Year by giving a kiss or a hug to someone nearby when the clock strikes 12. In the Bible you see this phrase to "greet one another with a holy kiss" used a number of times by the Apostles Paul and Peter. What do they mean? And why don't we greet with "holy kisses" in our churches today?

I believe we can get caught up trying to figure out or theologically explain what they meant. We either get going down a "rabbit hole" or we try to merely dismiss it as the culture of the day. The importance of this is in "GREETING" one another. As believers we are called to gather together and encourage one another in fellowship, all the more as we see The Day (Christ's second coming) approaching. Whatever we do, I want you to note it is to be a "holy" greeting. Holy means it should honor God and place a value on that person such as God does. He sees each person as a precious soul that He loves dearly and desires to know and have a personal relationship with.

I want to encourage you to greet people well this coming year. Greet them in a holy manner no matter who they are. Oh, you don't have to give them a "holy kiss," but greet them as a precious soul and dear person as they truly are that to God.


