Proverbs 14:4

Recently I heard a sermon preached with the title listed above. The pastor did a tremendous job, and it was a text that the Holy Spirit knew I needed to hear.

We've been studying the book of Proverbs on Wednesday evenings for a while now and finding that God's wisdom can transform all of life. Though the Proverbs are not promises they apply God's knowledge and wisdom for us all. One commentator put it this way as he described the book of Proverbs.....

"It is a book which seldom takes you to church. Like its own figure of Wisdom, it calls across to you in the street about some every day matter, or points things out at home. Its function in Scripture is to put godliness into working clothes." (Proverbs, Kidner, p. 35)

If there were no milk cows, my job would have been easy—there would have been no manure to sling. Be thankful, my dear friends, for the "dirty barn" and look for God at work in our lives and the lives of those around us. May you and I be faithful, trust in the Lord with all our hearts, and live pressing forward knowing the "blessings" of a dirty barn.
