We Believe.....

- The **Bible** is the inspired and inerrant Word of God, the authority in all matters of faith and life.

- Christians are called to be **salt and light**, separated from the ways of the world, and that this difference is to be reflected in the life of the congregation as well as in the institutions of the church body.
