<u>Hebrews 9:22</u> ...the law requires that nearly everything be **cleansed with blood**, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

<u>Isaiah 53:5-6</u> ...he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and **by his** wounds we are healed. ⁶ We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Ephesians 1:7 In him we have **redemption through his blood**, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace

<u>1 John 2:2</u> He is the **atoning sacrifice** for our sins, and not only for ours but also **for the sins of the whole world**.

<u>Romans 3:23-25a</u> ...all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. ²⁵ God presented Christ as a **sacrifice of atonement**, through the shedding of his blood—to be **received by faith**.

<u>Romans 3:23</u> the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

<u>1 Peter 3:18</u> ...Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body **but made** alive in the Spirit.

<u>1 Corinthians 15:16-17</u> ...if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. ¹⁷ And **if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile**; you are still in your sins...

<u>1 Corinthians 15:20-21</u> But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man.

<u>John 14:19</u> Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.

<u>John 10:17-18</u> The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life—only to **take it up again**. ¹⁸ No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own

accord. I have authority to lay it down and **authority to take it up again**. This command I received from my Father.

<u>John 15:5</u> I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; **apart from me you can do nothing**.

<u>John 16:7</u> ...it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

<u>Titus 3:5</u> he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the **washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit**

<u>Ephesians 1:13-14</u> ...you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

<u>1 Corinthians 6:11</u> ...you were **washed**, you were **sanctified**, you were **justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and **by the Spirit** of our God.

Romans 8:26-27 ... the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the **Spirit himself intercedes for us** through wordless groans. ²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.

<u>Romans 8:11</u> ...if the **Spirit** of him who **raised Jesus from the dead** is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead **will also give life to your mortal bodies** because of his Spirit who lives in you.

<u>John 14:26</u> ...the Advocate, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in my name, **will teach you** all things and **will remind you** of everything I have said to you.

<u>Acts 1:8</u> ...you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Romans 12:6a We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of
