Association of Free Lutheran Congregations (AFLC)

• The **Bible** is the inspired and inerrant Word of God, the authority in all matters of faith and life.

- In the **Trinity**, that God the Father is Creator of the world, Jesus is the Son of God and Savior of the world, and the Holy Spirit is the Comforter and Teacher to the world.
- **Jesus** is God in the flesh, Who lived a perfect life, died on the cross for all sin, has risen from the dead and is coming to earth again.
- The teaching and **preaching of God's Word** is the main task of the Church, to be conducted in such a way that the saints are built up and unbelievers see their need for salvation:
- The **congregation** is the right form of the Kingdom of God on earth, with no authority above it but the Word of God and Spirit of God.
- True **Christian unity** is a spiritual concept, not a manmade organization such as the World Council of Churches or the National Council of Churches
- Christians are called to be **salt and light**, separated from the ways of the world, and that this difference is to be reflected in the life of the congregation as well as in the institutions of the church body.
